FIU's goAML services transition to new domain

The Seychelles Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU) wishes to inform all reporting entities and relevant external stakeholders that, following the completion of the system maintenance communicated through its Notice No. 4 of 2026, the FIU's goAML services have been restored and are now accessible through a new primary domain.

Effective August 18, 2026, the goAML platform will no longer operate under the **"fiu.sc"** domain and will instead operate under the domain **"fiuseychelles.sc"**.

Accordingly, the goAML services for the submissions of Suspicious Transaction Reports and Suspicious Activity Reports (STRs/SARs), Virtual Assets-related (VA) disclosures and Beneficial Ownership (BO) information will now be accessible through the following new official links:

All reporting entities and relevant stakeholders are requested to update any bookmarks, saved links, internal references or other links to the goAML portal and only use the new official goAML links for submissions.

With the restoration of the goAML services, the FIU will no longer accept STRs/SARs submissions by email from the effective date of this notice. Reporting entities that were required to submit STRs/SARs manually by email during the system maintenance period should resume electronic submission through goAML.

Updates to the goAML platform

Further, as part of the recent system maintenance exercise, the FIU has implemented additional security and system measures across the goAML platform.

One-Time Password (OTP) authentication

Users will now be required to enter a One-Time Password (OTP) as part of the goAML login process. The OTP will be sent to the email address registered to the user's goAML account.

This additional authentication step has been introduced to strengthen account security and provide an additional layer of protection when accessing the goAML platform.

Reporting entities are therefore reminded to ensure that the email address registered to each user's goAML account remains updated.

Report cleanup and archiving

A stricter cleanup and archiving process has also been implemented across the goAML platform.

The cleanup period has been reduced to **seven (7) days**. Accordingly, submitted reports will be archived from the reporting entity's side **seven (7) days** after submission.



Once a report has been archived, it will no longer be available for retrieval by the reporting entity through its goAML account. The FIU will, however, continue to retain a copy of all submitted reports.

Reporting entities that wish to maintain their own copy of a submitted report are therefore advised to download and securely retain the report within seven (7) days of submission.
